Edgewood College Announces Education Stimulus Plan Students will be awarded \$1,000 to use at any graduate program in Wisconsin

Madison- Given the state of the economy, Edgewood College is introducing a stimulus plan of its own, an education stimulus plan. Edgewood College will begin accepting on-line applications April __ for one of twenty \$1,000 scholarships to be used at any Wisconsin college or university. The plan acknowledges that in a time of economic crisis, the only real safety net is a quality education.

“Edgewood College has always put education before the college, meaning we really want to help people invest in themselves through a quality education, even if they don’t choose to do it at Edgewood College,” said Ed Taylor, Director of Marketing and Communications. “This is even more important now that the economy has taken a bad turn.
