Findorff Hits the Nail on the Head for Project Home

Madison- May 2nd marked the 8th year that J.H. Findorff & Son has worked with Project Home on their Hammer with a Heart event to help low income neighbors throughout Dane County with home repairs they aren't able to do themselves.

“We look forward to this event every year,” said Amy Recob, Marketing Manager for Findorff. “It’s a crazy day trying to get all the work done and feeding all those volunteers. But, we love being able to give back to those that really need the help.” This year, Findorff increased their title sponsorship to also include being the food sponsor, feeding more than 160 volunteers. In addition, fundraisers were held at the Findorff office resulting in a \$1,500 donation to go towards supplies.

Project Home’s mission is to improve the quality and affordability of housing to low-to-moderate income residents in Dane County. The Hammer with a Heart event is the culmination of their efforts, using area volunteers and skilled workers that donate their time to make repairs on selected area houses. This year’s event took place on Saturday May 2nd.

“This program and all the volunteers have made such a difference in my life,” said one homeowner wishing to be identified only as Ray. “I’ve always been independent and done repairs myself, but I can’t do it anymore. A few of the Findorff volunteers came back on their own to do repairs that couldn’t be finished that day. They did it to make my home safe for *me!* This has been a life saving experience.”
